More than 40 countries from Europe, Africa, Asia and North and South America together with major international organizations such as World Bank, European Unions, United Nations, etc. attend the meeting and focuses mainly on current tax and development issues with the following agenda:

1. Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (BEPS)
2. Multinational Enterprise financial reporting
3. Transparency
4. Exchange of Information
5. Addressing tax evasion and illicit financial flows
6. Tax Policy – Natural Resource Taxation, Tax Incentives and Evidence Based Policy Design
7. Aid, Development Cooperation and Taxation
